What do NZers *really* think about legalising the recreational use of cannabis?

Curia Market Research – 1,000 respondents – April 2019

OVERALL PREFERRED OPTION

65% want restrictions lifted for MEDICAL use but not for RECREATIONAL use

18% want restrictions lifted for RECREATIONAL use

7% want to keep the law as it currently is

(10% unsure or refused to say)

85% say cannabis use can damage the brains of young people

81% of respondents think that drivers using cannabis are more likely to cause accidents

63% of respondents think cannabis users aged under 25 are less likely to get a job
(20% – makes no difference)

49% think cannabis usage will increase if restrictions are reduced
(35% – remain the same)

22% think tobacco companies want restrictions on cannabis to be lifted.
(36% disagree) 42% are unsure
