Official Information Act 1982 request

Thank you for your Official Information Act 1982 (OIA) request of 18 September 2018 regarding abortion data. Specifically, your request was for the following information:

- 1. Our understanding is that since 1988 32 people have been charged with procuring abortion (s183 Crimes Act). Of those, 12 were convicted.
 - a. Could you confirm that this is information is correct. If not, could you provide the correct figures
 - b. Please provide the details for each charge and whether the charge was under s 183(1)(a), (b) or (c) or a combination of those subsections for each charge
 - c. Please provide what the 12 defendants (or the correct number) were convicted for
 - d. What was the punishment for the 12 convictions (or the correct number of convictions)

In response to part 1a of your request, I have provided you with the number of people charged and convicted of abortion related offences under sections 183 of the Crimes Act 1961. Please see Table 1 attached.

In response to part 1b of your request for the details of each charge, this information is not recorded by the Ministry of Justice. The information may be held by the courts which are excluded from the operation of the OIA under section 2(6)(a). Therefore, I am refusing part 1b of your request under section 18(g)(i) of the OIA as there are no grounds for believing that the information is held by another department, Minister of the Crown, organisation, or local authority.

In response to part 1c and 1d of your request, I have provided you with the number of people convicted of abortion related offences under section 183 of the Crimes Act 1961 by charge, sentence and financial year. Please see Table 2 attached.

The number of people convicted is different from previous information released due to the offence code 1.55 being including in this instance. Offence code 1159 s a code that can be used to cover a criminal act under sections 182-187 of the Crimes Act 1961. Given section 183 falls within that range it has been included.
