

EUTHANASIA REFERENDUM 2020



Introduction

This analysis looks at 123 New Zealand-based media articles and opinion pieces as they appeared online during the Euthanasia referendum campaign period between May and October 2020. The objective was to assess the extent to which the set of articles and op-eds, as a whole, provided balanced coverage of both sides of debate – consistent with the New Zealand Media Council's first principle of "accuracy, fairness and balance."

All the articles obtained were based on the list provided by *NZ Politics Daily*, a comprehensive, non-partisan list of articles, columns, and analysis relating to New Zealand politics and government, produced by the Democracy Project at Victoria University Wellington. This list was used to maintain the neutrality of the analysis and to avoid any accusation of searching for articles that leaned to one side or the other of the debate.

There were 75 news items and 48 opinion pieces.

Accuracy, fairness and balance was assessed across a variety of measures: the headline used, the number of people quoted within each piece arguing one or other side of the referendum question, and the proportion of content arguing each side of the campaign issues. Experts who quoted research or data were considered to be neutral. Any observed imbalance in the content or coverage across the set of news items and opinion pieces is interpreted as evidence of overall bias in reporting on the referendum question.

The report was commissioned by Family First New Zealand.


The analysis has been audited by an Emeritus Professor who specialises in research methods and statistics.

Analysis

1. Headlines - News Articles

Many readers do not have time to read the entire article, and in fact may only read the headline. The choice of headlines has potential for bias to the extent that, overall, they favour one or other side of the referendum question.

In the event, news article headlines were not found to be strongly biased towards either side of the Euthanasia referendum, with 80% (60) being assessed as neutrally worded. Of the remaining 15 headlines, 9 were biased towards the YES position and 6 towards the NO position.



2. Comments From Advocates – News Articles

On average, advocates promoting the NO position were quoted slightly more often than YES advocates.

46 of the 75 articles quoted at least one person from the NO campaign, whereas 42 articles quoted at least one person from the YES campaign.

Quotes from NO advocates were however a little more likely to be published at the bottom of the story, compared to quotes from YES advocates which were more likely to lead a given story.

Overall, a total of 71 NO advocates and 58 YES advocates were quoted across all 75 news articles published.

3. Overall Bias In News Articles

The overall bias was a subjective indicator based on all the elements measured and reflecting the indices surveyed.

No significant bias was observed either way, with YES advocates making up 51.7% of all quotes and NO advocates making up 48.3% of all quotes.

Articles with a 100% bias were slightly more likely to favour the YES (10) rather than the NO (6) side of the argument.



4. Op-Eds

48 opinion-editorials were published during the campaign period.

Op-eds were more likely to have a NO-bias (half of all op-eds) compared to one third of all op-eds with a YES-bias.



5. News Outlet Bias

Across the major news outlets there was a slight YES-leaning bias compared to a NO-leaning bias, with TVNZ, RNZ, The NZ Herald and Spinoff being above the 45%-55% range. The ODT demonstrated a clear NO-leaning bias across all of their stories.

Unlike the cannabis referendum coverage, there was no significant bias by individual reporters observed – which is to be commended.

Conclusion

Across all 123 news and op-ed pieces on the Euthanasia Referendum, the coverage came out overall as balanced and reasonably representative of views on both sides.

Op-eds were somewhat more likely to represent the NO-vote – whereas news items leaned a little towards representing the YES-vote overall.

When considered by news outlet, four had a slight bias (56-58%) towards the YES-vote position, three sat within a reasonably balanced (45-55%) range, and one was clearly biased (70%) towards the NO position.

While this suggests some scope for more balanced coverage by a few news outlets, our research did not uncover any significant bias across the full set of news pieces and op-eds when considered as a whole.

On balance, both sides of the euthanasia referendum were given similar coverage, and we are satisfied that the full range of arguments was properly presented by the media to the voting public.
